**AS ‘ONE OF AMERICA’S TOP COURSES’**

The course that’s hosted U.S. Open qualifying in 2003 and 2005 is the current home to the Illinois PGA Section Championship and now has a home in the popular “Zagat Guide to America’s Top Golf Courses” for 2006-2007.

One of just four Lake County golf courses to earn entry in the Zagat Guide, Stonewall Orchard received high marks for course conditions, facilities, service and overall value. Zagat’s ‘America’s Top Golf Courses’ list featured more than 6,000 golfers who reviewed 1,095 courses in the U.S., including the Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico.

According to Zagat’s entry for Stonewall Orchard: “Suburban golfers say that golf at this ‘sleeper’ can’t get any better, especially at this price, as the 1999 track is extremely well-conditioned and architect Arthur Hills’ imaginative layout provides lots of different looks across diverse terrain.”

Located in northwest suburban Grayslake, Stonewall Orchard has been ranked “One of the Best in State” by the editors of Golf Digest for the past three seasons. The lack of homes along the course as well as 65,000 mature pine trees and oak trees make Stonewall Orchard a virtual retreat as rarely do golfers even see other groups on nearby holes due to the secluded feel the course offers.
