

Stonewall Orchard Golf Club – Golf Policy 3/25

Golf Course is Open - With Restrictions

The most recent COVID Executive Order (Rev 3-24) from the Governor's Office is that: If a golf course opens, the clubhouse must remain closed, it may not provide food or beverage service, including food or beverage cart service, or allow the use of golf carts by golfers. Only online or telephone scheduling is allowed. Golfers and staff must observe social distancing guidelines while at the golf course.

Stonewall Orchard is committed to strictly adhering to the policies and best practices from other industry professionals, CDC and the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity. Below are the guidelines for playing at Stonewall Orchard:

- **Online Prepayment is the preferred method.** When booking a reservation online you will be required to prepay. We can also accept prepayment over the phone. No cash will be accepted. Walk on players can phone us from the parking lot. Lastly, we will be reserving only every other tee time to ensure social distancing.
- **Walking Only** - No motorized or push carts will be provided. Guests are welcome to bring their own push carts
- The Clubhouse will be closed which includes the restrooms. No Food & Beverage service will be allowed and bringing your own alcohol is illegal. Proshop sales are prohibited
- All rakes, ball washers, water coolers have been removed from the course.
- The cups will be raised and flagsticks are to not be touched.
- The driving range will remain closed

Social Distancing practices are expected and will be enforced for the safety of everyone. Flattening the curve should remain everyone's top priority so If you feel sick please stay home!
